

Recent Legislative Actions by the Mayor and Council

February 11, 2013

1. Action to determine permitting process for CSX Railroad expansion, *made by CM Bee and second by CM Pooley*. Motion passed, Mayor Kerns in favor
2. Action to obtain an actuarial study for valuation report to enter the Maryland State Retirement and Pension System, not to exceed \$5,852, *made by CM Pooley, and second by CM White*. Motion passed, Mayor Kerns in favor

March 11, 2013

1. Action to designate Council Member Pooley as the Town of Edmonston's representative to ATHA's governing board, *made by CM Bee and second by CM White*. Motion passed, Mayor Kerns in favor
2. Introduction of Ordinance 2013 OR 1; amending Chapter 4 "Admission and Amusement tax", Re.: Increasing amusement tax from 4% to 5%.

As you know, schools in Prince George's County will be closing soon, ending access to free or reduced cost breakfast and lunch programs for many of our community's children; unfortunately, for too many children **HUNGER DOES NOT TAKE A SUMMER VACATION.** To fill in the gap, I have been working hard on two fronts to meet this need; increasing the number of sites offering summer meals as well as expanding the number of food pantry locations in high risk neighborhoods. Kids and families shouldn't have to be hungry when school is out.

No Kid Hungry Maryland: Prepared summer meals are available at participating churches, community centers, park programs and churches in our community. To find a location near you call 1-877-731-9300 or go to www.nokidhungrymd.org. You can put in your zip code and find a convenient location for either lunch or breakfast and lunch. Getting the word out is so important to our families. We want children and teenagers to develop health eating habits and not have to rely on chips and soda to fill them up this summer.
