Calling all residents in and around Riverdale, Riverdale Park, Eastpines, Templeton Knolls, Beacon Heights, Bladensburg and the Port Towns, Woodlawn and Lanham.

Homeowners in area neighborhoods are eligible for a free professionally planted native tree (or two). We especially want sites for larger shade trees 40-80 feet high like Sweetgum, American Linden, American Elm, Pin Oak, Scarlet Oak, Southern Red Oak, and Red Maple. Medium trees 30-60 feet high are Hackberry and American Hornbeam. Serviceberry, Sweetbay Magnolia, and Eastern Redbud are smaller trees 20-30 feet high.

This tree canopy project is a service of the Central Kenilworth Avenue Revitalization CDC (CKAR) in cooperation with our county's Department of the Environment, the Chesapeake Bay Trust and participating communities and organizations. Homeowners must agree to regularly water and mulch their tree for one year.
